

- Description:** Blockchain Technology and its applications as for example Decentralized Finance, Tokenisation, NFTs, etc. are highly interdisciplinary topics and therefore pose a substantial challenge for researchers and practitioners alike.
- The goal of this seminar is to foster the exchange of ideas across various disciplines, including law, economics and computer science. Therefore, this course targets interested students from the Faculty of Law and the Faculty of Business and Economics of the University of Basel. The attending students should be willing to acquire knowledge in different disciplines, work right at the research frontier, prepare and present their findings, and assume an active role in the discussion.
- Examination:** The students are expected to write a seminar paper and present their findings in the block seminar followed by a discussion presentation.
